Tips to Prevent Fraud

- Check Bank Statements Monthly and Credit Reports Quarterly
- Educate yourself or family member on current scams
- Talk to family member about new "online friends"
- Encourage your family member to check in with someone they trust before giving any money away
- Use updated cyber security software
- Encourage your family member to let unknown phone numbers go to voicemail so you can review them together
- Educate your family member to email scams. Encourage them to never open email attachments unless they can confirm the sender. They can even call the company to confirm the attachment.
- Remove your family members name from call lists. You can do this by calling - 888-382-1222
